









IMPORTANT:

- On Apple, the right mouse button seems to be a click together with the “Apple” key pressed (instead of the control-key as usual)
- On tablet PCs the right click is when the button on the pen is pressed. A left click is pressing the pen onto the surface.

Gesture	Mouse-buttons	Command	Notes
	Right	Gesture drawn over a node: Delete the node	The root node cannot be deleted The gesture is meant to be a “cross out”
	Right	Show the about dialog	The gesture is meant to be an upper case “A”
	Right	Create a new slide and append it to the end	The new slide is opened instantly The gesture is meant to be a kind of arrow pointing to “here”
	Right	Delete the current slide	No warning! Be careful!! The gesture is meant to be an arrow pointing to the top for “throw it away”
	Right	Go to next slide	
	Right	Go to previous slide	
Click on a slide in the slide overview	Left	Go to the selected slide	
	Right	Show/hide slide overview	
	Right	Select objects within the circle	
Click on node	Left	Select the clicked node	To deselect click on the node again. Clicking somewhere on the drawing surface does not deselect the node!
Click on selected node and move mouse while holding the button	Left	Move the node	Node has to be selected

Draw a line from one node to another node of another branch	Left	Insert an arrow between two nodes	Arrow has major layout problems... You have to start and end on a point above the nodes where the node COULD also be selected. See note for "Insert new Node"
Draw a line starting on an existing node and ending somewhere on the empty drawing surface	Left	Insert a new node and connect it with a branch to the origin node	If it does not work at once: You have to find a start point where you COULD also select the node (but do not select it for inserting!), that is, where the node reacts on input. Sometimes, the branches are receiving the click instead of the nodes and then inserting a new one does not work
Draw on the node label only	Left	Write onto node	Currently, the size of the node is fixed and does not increase dynamically
Draw a straight (right click) line into some direction	Right	Scroll the view into the indicated direction	Some conflicts with the next/previous/new/delete slide gestures. So may not work properly. Use arrowkeys instead.
